



A large fishery stocked well with many carp up to around 23lb+.

There are car parking facilities on-site but may require you to walk a short distance.

Throughout the year the lake can be very challenging, what we mean by this is the growth of many varieties of weed. This water currently has a fast growth rate from around March to October time, then dies off during the winter months. It gets cut by springboard for the water events but anglers may sometimes find it difficult to find swims.

Main club rules for this lake;

1. Boilies are allowed.
2. No more than 2 rods for 1 EA licence and a maximum of 3 rods for the optional extra EA licence.
3. Before fishing check the big lake is not being used for water sports. You can phone springboard (Tel: 0191 5266684). Before fishing you must book in via our website at <https://hlac.co.uk/bookings/>.
4. No day ticket fishing on the big lake (Members only).
5. An unhooking mat is required.
6. A carp care kit is required when carp fishing.
7. Micro barb hooks are allowed when carp fishing.

There are no pegs on this lake, however you can choose where to fish.
